## Obituaries

JOHN S.L. CRAGGS: "Jack" Craggs passed away recently and was a long-serving BDH supporter. Although throughout his life he didn't enjoy the best of health, nevertheless he was a keen mounted member, on foot with the Weardale Beagles, and latterly a car-follower. Jack served on the Hunt Supporters Committee for sometime, and was a knowledgeable volunteer Member of the Point to Point Committee "task force".

ALEXANDER WALKER: "Alec" died very suddenly in June, and was an 'unseen' part of BDH for many years, - His range of talents in the countryside were wide - Often assisting with earth-stopping, mending fences, stone-walling, helping with hounds and terrier work. Alec was always happy to help with any tasks needing to be done, indeed he was "Mr. Fix-it".

ROGER MANNING - Roger and his family came to live at Hedley in the 1990's, - from a keen hunting family in Leicestershire, he and his family were enthusiastic Members - Roger almost always one of the last to leave the field, whatever the weather, and he served on the Hunt Committee, - his wife Carole (who died just over 2 years ago) was a member of the Hunt Supporters Committee, and our condolences are expressed especially to his Daughter Laura, and Son James, who we remember as "dashing Pony Club youngsters" not so many years ago!

MARGARET BULLIVANT: "Peggy" as so many knew her, was a member of that well-known Thompson farming family from Lanchester where she lived most of her life, except when she married her husband Denis and opened the "Langley Close" Equestrian Centre, just up the hill, - (almost before Equestrian Centres were invented in this area!). She was a keen fox-hunter, and nationally made her mark as an experienced whip, often competing against the World Champion George Bowman and "House of Windsor"! At her funeral in the spring her sense of occasion and elegance was displayed to the end as a handsome pair of black horses carried her in a glass coach on her final journey.
